**Recall Instructions to 2nd and 3rd year MBBS students
JIPMER Puducherry and JIPMER Karaikal campuses**

With a consistently downward trend of COVID infections, it has been decided to recall the remaining undergraduate students back to JIPMER campuses for classes:

- 2nd year MBBS (5th semester)
- 3rd year MBBS (7th semester)

In-person classes will begin from 12th July 2021. COVID-appropriate behaviour as detailed below should be strictly followed by the students when on campus and elsewhere.

Students of above-mentioned years of JIPMER Puducherry residing outside Puducherry and students of JIPMER Karaikal residing outside Karaikal are advised to make travel arrangements such that they report to the respective campuses between 9th to 11th July 2021. Online classes during this travel period will be suspended. Students residing in Puducherry and Karaikal will attend classes at respective campuses directly from 12th July 2021.

Vaccination:

In order to protect students from COVID-19, vaccination has been offered to them at JIPMER from 16th January 2021 and it is learnt that the vast majority are completely vaccinated. Vaccination has been shown to reduce the chances of severe disease and death. Therefore, it is highly recommended and strongly advised that the remaining students also get vaccinated immediately with the exemption of those under 18 years of age, history of COVID illness in the past 90 days, and those with medical contraindications for vaccination. Such students who are yet to be vaccinated should get their first dose of Covishield immediately from the place where they reside now, so that there would be at least 2 weeks gap before they reach campus. The second dose of Covishield will be arranged at JIPMER after the required time gap. Those who are less than 18 years of age and had COVID illness in the recent past can get their vaccine at JIPMER when they become eligible.



All the above mentioned MBBS students **including day scholars** should fill the Google form (scan the QR code or use the link below) on or before 02.07.2021. <https://forms.gle/ELEwEbtX7XeTscgM8>

Those vaccinated should upload the certificate.

Note:

If you have a recent history of exposure to COVID-positive patients and/or if you are experiencing COVID-like symptoms, report to triage at SSB Annexe on arrival (to the caretaker for Karaikal hostellers) and follow the instructions given by the doctors there.

Those who are **not vaccinated should undergo a swab test** for COVID-19 on arrival.

Other students can enter their allotted hostel rooms directly. No quarantine or routine COVID testing is necessary.

Students who are **unable to report to the campus on the said dates should obtain due permission** from the Dean (Academic) in advance by writing an email with proper and detailed reasons to jipmerbbs@jipmer.edu.in.

COVID-appropriate behaviour:

- Wear tightly sealing 3-ply surgical or N-95 face-mask
- Maintain social distancing. Avoid parties, in-person celebrations, and gatherings. Additional care to avoid infection should be taken during eating or drinking in the mess/canteen.
- Practice hand hygiene.
- Follow these measures within the campus (including classrooms, work spaces, hostels, canteen, and mess) and elsewhere.
- Avoid going out of the campus unnecessarily. Outstation travel will require permission from the Head of the departments and the Dean (Academic).
- Visit triage at SSB Annexe / Karaikal GH if you experience COVID symptoms and get advice. Isolate yourself until test results. Inform the hostel warden/caretaker.

Those found not following the norms during periodic checks will face penal action that includes suspension from classes.
