It is our pleasure to invite you all for the 8th CNE Short term course on “Essential Skill Based Training for Nurses” (Funded by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India) from 20.11.2023 to 26.11.2023.

This workshop is conducting for seven days from 20.11.2023 to 26.11.2023. The 1st and 2nd day is skill based training on BLS/ACLS, 3rd day is neonatal resuscitation, 4th & 5th day is prevention of hospital acquired infection, 6th day is patient safety and 7th day is IUCD/PPIUCD insertion.

Objectives:

At the end of the course, the delegates will be able to:

- Develop the skill on BLS/ ACLS and neonatal resuscitation.
- Develop a skill on prevention of infection techniques.
- Explore the interpretation of ECG.
- Calculate the emergency drugs.
- Assist and prepare the ET tube intubation.
- Identify the different airway device and its advantages.
- Acquire knowledge in different types of arrhythmias and its management.
- Develop skill on prevention of hospital acquired infections.
- Develop skill on prevention of needle stick injury.
- Sensitize legal aspects in hospital acquired infections.
- Obtain knowledge on medical errors and strategies to prevent the medical errors.
- Gain knowledge on IUCD & PPIUCD.
- Develop skill in assisting insertion and removal of IUCD.
