

Health Camp at Navamal Maruthur Village on 23.07.2022

A Health camp was organized by the CMCHIS team in coordination with the department of Preventive and Social Medicine, JIPMER at Panchayat Union Middle School, Navamal Maruthur village, Villupuram district, Tamil Nadu on 23rd July 2022 (Saturday) from 8.30 am to 1 pm.

Services delivered in the camp:

1. General health check-up
2. Special consultation with the departments of Medicine, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, ENT, and Dermatology
3. Lab investigations – Random Blood Sugar estimation and Hemoglobin
4. Health education for the targeted audience
5. Referral to JIPMER and Kandamangalam PHC for those who required further management and follow up care.

A total of 157 people attended the camp in which majority were in the age group 46 – 60 years (34%), followed by more than 60 years (33%) and under 5 years (5%). Among the attendees, 51% were female. Around 127 above 5 years were screened for anemia and found 62 (49%) people with abnormal levels with 19 persons with moderate and 2 persons with severe anemia respectively. Persons with severe anemia were referred for further evaluation and treatment. Out of 127 screened for diabetes, 12 (9%) had abnormal values and advised dietary modifications and advised to adhere to treatment. People identified with cataract were advised for cataract surgery and people with diminished visual acuity were given prescription for spectacles.
