About the Symposium

Pharmacogenomics is an emerging field in the medical science. It deals with identifying genetic markers, which are associated with treatment response or adverse effects of treatments in individuals. With the implementation of Pharmacogenomics, optimal treatment can be chosen based on pre-emptive genetic testing, thus avoiding trial and error practice and its consequences. With major advances in genetic screening technologies and bioinformatics, the cost of pharmacogenomic testing has become affordable.

India has a vast and varied patient population and implementing pharmacogenetic testing in our country is an arduous task. However, Pharmacogenomics testing is already available in some parts of India. Soon, there will be a situation where patients will approach our clinicians with their genetic information. Educating clinicians about personalized medicine is the first and most important step in implementing pharmacogenomics testing in our country.

The relevance of Pharmacogenomics research in Indian population is very important since our population is unique when compared to other global populations. Hence, it is the need of the hour for our health care professionals to develop skills for applying pharmacogenomics in their medical speciality so that it can benefit the patient.

Personalized medicine is one of the most promising future avenues for patient care in various fields of medicine like Oncology, Cardiology, Neurology, Psychiatry, Pediatrics, Geriatrics and almost in all the medical specialities. Pharmacogenomics is a vital cog in the wheel of Personalized medicine. Principles of Pharmacogenomics is therefore an important step towards implementing personalized medicine.

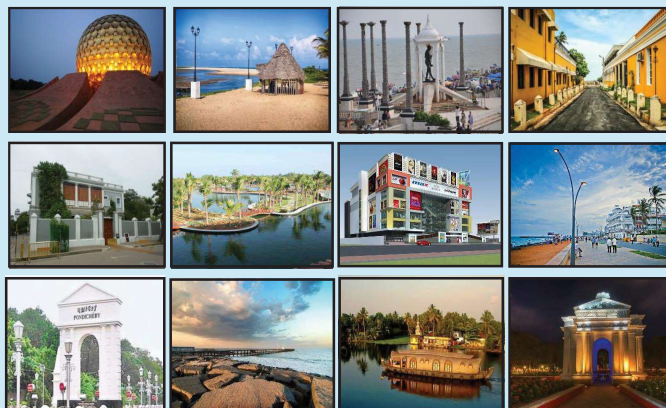
Abstracts will be reviewed by the members of the scientific committee for suitability of acceptance. The intimation of the acceptance will be informed to your email.
