JIPMER, PUDUCHERRY

- ❖ Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research, Puducherry (JIPMER) under the Government of India since the year 1956, is one of the leading Medical Institutions in India. Spread over a sprawling 195 Acre campus in an urban locale of Puducherry (formerly Pondicherry), JIPMER is 170 km from Chennai by road.
- ❖ JIPMER has been declared as an “Institution of National Importance” by an Act of Parliament, JIPMER, Puducherry, Act, 2008. A copy of the Act was Gazette notified on 14-7-2008 to enforce this Act. Prior to this the Institute was functioning under the administrative control of Directorate General of Health Service, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi.
- ❖ The Institution is now empowered to award Medical Degrees, Diplomas, etc., under the clauses 23 & 24 of the said Act. Such Degrees / Diploma, etc., shall be deemed to be included in the schedules to the respective Acts governing Medical Council of India, Indian Nursing Council and Dental Council of India, entitling the holders to the same privileges as those attached to the equivalent awards from the recognized Universities of India.

According to candidate's qualification, he/ she can choose any one project stream. For each project stream, syllabus and marks distribution is given for the written test on the next page. During interview the shortlisted candidates will be given option to choose topic within the project stream.

ELIGIBILITY:

A candidate seeking admission to the course of study leading to the award of PhD degree must possess any one of the following qualifications:

1. **(a) Medical qualification:** MD/MS/DM/MCh from a recognized medical college or Diplomate of National Board of Examination in the particular subject as per the requirement of the project (See table above). The degree(s) should have been registered with the MCI.
2. **(b) Nursing Qualification:** M.Sc. degree in a nursing specialty (for College of Nursing). The degree(s) should have been registered with the INC
- (c) Non-Medical Qualification:** Master's Degree (2/3-year course) from a UGC-recognized Indian University or equivalent in the subject as per requirement of the project (See table above).
3. Candidates should have at least 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.
4. Candidates with Master's Degree through a distance-learning mode are NOT ELIGIBLE
5. The candidates, who are likely to complete requisite qualification and degree by **31st March 2023** may also apply. However, they must complete all the requirements for such qualification by this date, and those completing these after **31st March 2023** will not be eligible.

METHOD OF SELECTION

The selection of PhD candidates will be based on the **aggregate marks scored in written test based on multiple choice questions and viva-voce examination**. Candidates scoring 50% or more marks in written and viva separately will only qualify for selection. A total of 9 seats are available for the year 2023.

I. Pattern of Written Test

The written test is based on multiple choice questions. One mark will be awarded for one correct answer. Each wrong answer will score (minus 0.25) Mark. Based on the PhD project stream, the written test pattern is divided into six **project streams** such as

2. **Project Stream II (Public Health)**
3. **Project Stream III (Obst. & Gynae.)**

Candidates should indicate their choice of project stream (Only one) at the time of application

MERIT

- Merit Ranking would be based on **PERCENTAGE**
- Minimum percentage for eligibility to Viva-Voce examination is **50%**
- Candidates who secure less than the minimum PERCENTAGE in the Entrance Examination will NOT be shortlisted for VIVA-VOCE
- No e-mail or written communication will be entertained in this regard

METHOD OF RESOLVING TIES

In case of two or more candidates securing equal PERCENTAGE in the entrance examination their inter se merit shall be determined in the following order:

1. Negative marks:

The candidate who has less negative mark will be placed higher than that of the other candidate.

2. Age:

If a tie still exists, the candidate elder by age will be ranked higher.

I. Viva-Voce examination

Only those candidates who have scored **50% and above in the written examination**, will be shortlisted for the viva-voce examination. The viva-voce examination panel consists of Director, Dean (Research), Dean (Academic) and prospective guides in the respective groups. The candidates will be tested on the knowledge of theory and practical aspects of the subjects they have studied in their postgraduate courses.

The selection of PhD candidates will be based on the aggregate marks scored in written test based on multiple choice questions and viva-voce examination. The candidates can go through the concept proposals of projects they are interested in before the viva-voce examination. The shortlisted candidates will be allotted topics as per their choices (if available) in the order of their rank from within the project stream they had opted for.

Change of project stream:

Once chosen, change of project stream is NOT permitted on any account.

NOTE: The Viva-voce date will be announced later on the JIPMER website. The selection process may extend to two days if the number of applicants is more and hence the candidates should come prepared for the same. No arrangements for boarding or lodging will be provided by JIPMER.

INSTITUTE PhD STIPEND: *

1. Candidates without financial assistance from extramural sources shall receive stipend from the Institute at the rate of Rs. 25,000/- per month for first three years.
2. Extension period stipend Rs. 20,000/- month only, restricted to another 2 yrs.
3. No stipend will be given beyond 5 years under any circumstances.

*Updated PhD stipend amount shall be followed as per "Standing Academic Committee" revised stipend structure from time to time.

DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The candidates registered for PhD as full-time research scholars shall conduct research work for a minimum period of three (3) years from the date of provisional registration.

He/she shall attend the department for research on all working days, except for periods when he/she is allowed to visit other institutions/laboratories for activities connected with research for a period permitted by the concerned guide and competent authorities.

The full time PhD research scholars availing intramural fellowship and grants shall actively participate in all the academic programmes of the department and institute.

Maximum duration of the PhD:

The duration of the course and certification of research experience will be the time period from provisional registration to submission of the thesis. The maximum period of the course shall not exceed five years for full time candidates and six years for part time candidates from the date of provisional registration. During this period, it is mandatory for the candidate to work in the department.

No financial support will be provided beyond 5 years by institute under any circumstances. Extension beyond six years can only be granted by the competent authority. However, under no circumstances the duration of the PhD shall exceed six years for a full time PhD scholar. The registration of the candidates who are unable to complete their course within the above stipulated period shall stand cancelled automatically. Such scholars shall no longer be eligible for any PhD in this Institute.

LEAVE AND OTHER RULES:

1. Only 30 days' leave is permitted in a given year.
2. Two conference leaves, not exceeding a total of ten (10) days, will be permitted in a year. The leave will be sanctioned if the scholar presents a paper from her/his thesis work.
3. If they wish to attend any other conference, they will have to avail leave from their sanctioned 30 days. Leave for undergoing training and attending workshops will be considered as given below (point 5).
4. The women candidates shall be entitled for maternity leave for 135 days (4.5 months) only as per existing rules.
5. In case the guide recommends a candidate for specific training or project related work outside JIPMER (within India or abroad), the leave shall be treated as on duty/study leave without any financial implications for JIPMER in this regard. This study leave shall not be for more than 6 months in the entire registration period. The proof of acceptance of the candidate for such training/work outside should be submitted and on return, the report of such training/work done shall be required to be submitted to the Dean (R), by the candidate through the guide.

BREAK OF STUDY:

PhD is a continuous programme, and hence a **break of study cannot be granted under any circumstances**, including medical grounds. Students can leave the course mid-way only by discontinuing the course and their names will be removed from the roll of this institute. No Correspondence in this regard will be entertained under any circumstances.

Accommodation In-campus accommodation facilities are limited and there is no guarantee that PhD scholars will be provided accommodation. They will have to make their own arrangements to get a suitable accommodation outside the campus.

PENALTY FOR DISCONTINUATION OF PhD:

In the event, he/ she discontinues the course for any reasons within 12 months, he / she will be levied a fine of Rs. 25,000/-; between 12 to 24 months, he/ she has to pay Rs. 50,000/- and between 24 -36 months, he / she has to pay Rs. 75,000/-.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: THROUGH ONLINE MODE ONLY.

- 1) Candidates seeking admission to entrance examination are required to apply online mode only. (Any other mode of application will not be accepted.)

- 3) Read the prospectus and instructions carefully.
- 4) Candidates need NOT send hard copy of the application

IMPORTANT

- a. The photograph must be taken with a placard while the placard is being held by the candidate indicating name of candidate and date of taking photograph. If name and date are written/edited on the photograph after capturing it, the application will be rejected.

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

- Entrance Examination will be conducted through a **Computer Based Test (CBT) [Online] only.**
- The examination shall be held on **Sunday, 02nd April, 2023 9.00 AM – 10.30 AM**
- The duration of the examination shall be **1½ hours (One Hour and Thirty minutes).**
- Therefore, all candidates will be required to appear at CBT Online Entrance Examination, which will be conducted on **Sunday, 02nd April, 2023.**
- The venue and time of the examination will be mentioned in the Admit Card/Hall Ticket.
- No candidate will be permitted to appear in the examination unless he/she holds a valid "Admit Card/Hall ticket" issued by the Institute and a proof of their identification.

- **The allotment of Exam City would be as per the order of preference chosen by applicant during online registration on a FIRST-CUM-FIRST SERVE basis and on the availability of a vacancy at the chosen centre.**
- JIPMER, depending upon local conditions, reserves the right to allot any other Exam City other than the preferences given by the applicant.
- **NO request for change of center would be considered under any circumstances.**
- The Exam City preference is only indicative and is subject to change; Jawaharlal Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education & Research retains the final decision on the same and its allotment.
- If seats for Entrance Exam are unavailable in the chosen 3 exam cities, nearby (exam) cities will be considered for the venue.
- In case of any unforeseen circumstances, the Exam City can be cancelled at any point of time and a new Exam City can be allotted en bloc with due intimation in website/ text message.

METHOD OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION:

- **The examination shall be conducted in ENGLISH medium ONLY.**
- The Entrance Examination consists of **70 single best response type MCQs (All compulsory) having four alternatives and the questions will be asked from concerned subjects of the respective project stream.**
- **Candidates are advised to go through the Mock Test for computer-based Test (online examination). Link for mock test will be available on JIPMER Website at the link JIPMER PhD Entrance Examination – 2023.**

HALL TICKETS:

- Hall Tickets for the Entrance Examination shall be available for download to candidates whose applications are complete in all respects, from **30.03.2023 (Thursday); 11:00 AM (Tentative)**
- The Hall Ticket will contain
 - (1) **Name and date of birth as typed by the candidate in the application**
 - (2) **Photo and signature image as uploaded by the candidate**
 - (3) **Examination City allotted and Roll Number.**
- **NO change in the category/age/name/DOB (Date of Birth) will be entertained after submission of application. The candidates in such case have to apply afresh before the closing date.**
- **Request for rectification / change of any other details in the hall ticket shall NOT be considered under any circumstance.**
- **Candidates should preserve their hall ticket (with the signature and seal of the centre representative / Invigilator) after the completion of the exam and need to produce the same hall ticket during counseling.**
- **Candidates will NOT be allowed to appear for the Entrance Examination unless he/she produces the hall ticket downloaded from the JIPMER website at the exam centres along with ID proof in original & a photocopy of the same.**

Candidate will **NOT** be permitted to leave the exam hall before **10:30 AM** (i.e. time of closure of examination)

1. **Candidates are requested to be available in their allotted exam centres 2 hours before the commencement of the exam to avoid unnecessary tussle in the last minute. They are also advised to visit the exam venue one day before the examination to verify its location.**

11. Biometric iris scanning and face image capture will be done for every candidate on the day of Examination inside the examination hall by the authorized personnel.

12. The candidate must show, on demand, the hall ticket for admission in the examination hall. Candidates who do not produce the hall ticket issued by the JIPMER will not be admitted to the Examination Hall under any circumstances by the Center Superintendent.
13. During the examination, the invigilator will check the hall ticket of the candidates to satisfy himself / herself about the identity of each candidate.
14. Candidates are advised to check the seating plan that will be displayed outside the halls and identify the room / lab allotted as per their Hall Ticket number.
15. **Candidates will not be permitted to leave the exam hall until the exam is over, except in cases of acute health-related issues.**
16. Smoking in the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited.
17. Tea, coffee, cold drinks or food & snacks are **NOT** allowed in the Examination Halls.
18. The test will start exactly at the time mentioned in the Hall Ticket and an announcement to this effect will be made by the invigilator.


