Minutes of Fourth meeting of the Institute Ethics Committee (Human Studies) for the year 2014 held on 27.06.2014

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The Fourth meeting of the Institute Ethics Committee (Human Studies) for the year 2014 was held in NTTC Seminar Room, Academic Block (IV Floor), JIPMER on 27.06.2014 (Friday) from 9.30 AM onwards under the Chairmanship of Shri.S.Nadamuni, District Judge (Retd). The meeting was attended by Dr.Vasantha Muthuswamy (member), Dr. Nandini K. Kumar (Member), Dr. Zile Singh (Member), Dr.Santosh Kumar (Member), Dr. K. Chandrasekaran (Member), Dr. N.Sakthivel (Member), Ms. Usha (Member), and Dr. C. Adithan (Member Secretary) besides the concerned faculty and the post graduate students. The meeting started at 9.30 am with a welcome address by Member Secretary.

In the meeting a total of 28 proposals were discussed. After deliberations the following decisions were arrived at

- Number of proposals approved : 4
- Number of proposals approved subject to minor corrections : 24

In the beginning of the meeting, the Chairman explained the need for empowering the functioning of IEC while boosting medical research and clinical trials to solve health related problems. Subsequently, the Member Secretary informed the IEC members regarding the newly formed IEC. Following this Dr. Vasantha Muthuswamy gave her sincere appreciation to the Chairman and the Member Secretary for their contribution in improving the standards of IEC. She also suggested both of them need to guide the new committee and to organize a workshop for new committee members. The members in unison appreciated the Chairman of IEC for his guidance as well as humbleness and praised the Member Secretary for carrying out IEC meeting smoothly and commendably well. Following this the Chairman and Member Secretary thanked all the members, wished success to the new committee and concluded the session.

The investigators whose proposals need minor modifications are required to send three copies of revised proposals and CD to Dr. C. Adithan, Member-Secretary on or before 14-07-2014. If the revision is satisfactory, the approval certificate will be issued after consulting the chairman of the committee. Otherwise, they need to submit 15 copies of proposal (Form 1A) to IEC for its approval and it will be considered as fresh proposal.

For student projects, the guide should give a signed statement on a separate sheet with details of project proposal that “I take full responsibility and accountability for planning, execution and adverse events occurring during the study. The data collected and records will be retained by me.”
