The Heads of Departments concerned, who are conducting Postgraduate Degree [MD/MS/ PGDPHM/ M.Sc (Medical biochemistry)/ M.Sc (MLT)]/super specialty Postgraduate Degree (DM/ MCh/Post-Doctoral Fellow)/MPH courses, are informed that the postgraduate degree students admitted to their Departments for First year Postgraduate Degree (MD/MS)/ PGDPHM and second year M.Sc (Medical Biochemistry), and M.Sc (MLT) / First year super specialty Postgraduate Degree (DM/ M.Ch/ Post-Doctoral Fellow)/MPH courses, will have to submit the dissertation proposal in the prescribed format(Integrated-form-for-PG-research-protocols-Version-2.0-dated-22nd-October-2016)for approval by Postgraduate Research Monitoring Committee (PGRMC). Available at <http://jipmer.puducherry.gov.in/research/research-committees/postgraduate-research-monitoring-committee-pgrmc/proformas>

If any postgraduate degree [MD/MS/ PGDPHM/M.Sc (Medical Biochemistry)/ M.Sc (MLT)]/ super specialty Postgraduate Degree (DM/MCh/Post-Doctoral Fellow)/MPH student has not got approval by previous PGRMC meeting or require modifications of their proposal, may also be directed to submit their proposal for consideration.

The Heads of Departments concerned are requested to send the dissertation proposals allotted to the Postgraduate students in the prescribed proforma well in advance so as to reach the office of undersigned **on or before 31/08/ 2017. (August 31 2017)**

A grace period of 10 days will be considered under special circumstances with a penalty of Rs.10000. In case the student fails to submit within the grace period, he/she will allow to write the final exam six months after the regular date. Instructions for submission

1. Please use the Integrated-form-for-PG-research-protocols-Version-2.0-dated-22nd-October-2016 .(<http://jipmer.puducherry.gov.in/research/research-committees/postgraduate-research-monitoring-committee-pgrmc/proformas>)
2. The protocol including covering letter, data collection proforma and questionnaires/annexures if any should be combined and sent as **single MS Word file**. PDF files and scanned copies of word files will not be accepted.
3. Name the word file as” subject, candidate’s name, thesis title”, in that order. For example, if you’re Dr. Kumar, from anatomy and your topic is” Inguinal canal anatomy”. Your file should be named as “Anatomy, Kumar, Inguinal canal anatomy”.
4. **Two hard copies to be submitted to the office of the PGMRC, desk number 8, Dean research office, Administrative Block.** (Font size 11 of Times New Roman, 1.5 spacing, printed back to back on A4 size paper with page numbering)
5. One soft copy of the proposal should be **sent by e-mail** to ***submission.pgrmcjipmer@gmail.com***.
6. The subject (title) of your mail should be the same as your word document title. Mail the soft copy of your protocol as a **Single MS Word File Document** to the PGRMC submission email address.

Please note that the integrated PGMRC/IEC form has been updated to “Integrated-form-for-PG-research-protocols-Version-2.0-dated-22nd-October-2016 “ from January 2017 session of PGRMC . Residents are requested to submit the proposal only using the version 2.0 and to avoid using the older versions.
