1. The Director, JIPMER Puducherry, invites sealed tenders in Two Bid System (i.e. Technical and Financial Bid in separate sealed covers by post) from eligible Manufacturers / Firms / Companies / Authorized Agents / Distributors/ Dealers/ service providers on mutually agreed terms and conditions and satisfactory performance for **operating outpatient Haemodialysis services in JIPMER Yanam premises for one year (extendable up to two more years on same terms and conditions and mutually acceptable basis)**. Bidders are requested to quote their best offer along with the complete details of specifications, terms and conditions.

3. Eligibility Criteria for the Private Partner (Service provider)

- 3.1. Experience in serving active haemodialysis patients at their dialysis units within a geographical area of 100 km from Yanam
- 3.2. Should have experience operating a haemodialysis unit with a minimum of eight haemodialysis machines for a minimum duration of five years at a location within 100 km of Yanam
- 3.3. The haemodialysis service of the private partner (service provider) should have an operational facility for automated reprocessing of dialysers and should not be using manual reprocessing. Dialysis units using manual reprocessing shall be ineligible to be quoted as having experience providing dialysis treatment for this tender enquiry.
- 3.4. Turn over criteria. Bidder must have an annual turnover of 40 lakhs in the last three financial years.

4. Submission of bids

- 4.1. The Bidder must examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the e-tender document. The bid should be precise, complete, and in the prescribed format per the requirements of the bid document. The bid should not be conditional. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding document or submission of a bid that is not responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk. It may result in the rejection of the bid.
- 4.2. The Procurement of goods and services under this e-tender will be regulated as per the applicable provision of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), order 2017 of MoC and I (DIPP), Govt. Of India, therefore bidders who are claiming to be regulated under the said order are to submit documentary evidence in support of their claim.
- 4.3. The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and JIPMER, Puducherry will in no case be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4.4. Documents to be submitted

- 4.4.1. Bidder must download a copy of the tender document from the website. Sign all the pages of tender document and submit by post.
- 4.4.2. Annual turnover of last three financial years (auditor certificate- (2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24))
- 4.4.3. ITR of last three financial years (2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24)
- 4.4.4. Self-attested PAN copy
- 4.4.5. Self-attested GST copy
- 4.4.6. Bank details and a cancelled cheque
- 4.4.7. Certificate of registration as shop, clinical establishment or company etc.
- 4.4.8. Experience certificate as from the customer for whom service is provided documentary evidence is required.
- 4.4.9. EMD receipt

5. EMD

- 5.1. Tenderers need to deposit the EMD Amount of Rs 40,000 (Forty thousand only). **EMD should be paid through SBI COLLECT link (<http://jipmer.edu.in> -> Online payments -> tender fee) found in the JIPMER website (<http://jipmer.edu.in>) only.** No other form of payment is acceptable. The printout of the receipt for payment must be sent.
- 5.2. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after the payment of the performance security deposit. In case of unsuccessful bidders, the same would be returned soon after award of the contract to the successful bidder. JIPMER, Puducherry shall not pay any interest on EMD to any bidder.
- 5.3. The **EMD will be forfeited**, if the Tenderer withdraws or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of this tender. If the Tenderer having been notified of the acceptance of his tender by the Purchaser during the period of its validity:-fails or refuses to

furnish the performance security for the due performance of the contract or fails or refuses to accept/execute the contract or if it comes to notice that the information/documents furnished in its tender is incorrect, false, misleading or forged

- 5.4. **Exemption for EMD:** Firms registered with NSIC as a ‘Small-scale Industry’ or registered as Micro or Small (but not Medium) enterprise for manufacture of Medical Equipment/Instrument Apparatus are exempted from submission of EMD. A copy of the relevant certificate such Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum, valid at the time of bidding, must be submitted to claim EMD exemption. It is to be noted that traders of micro or small enterprise, participating in this e-Tender must be registered as Micro/ Small enterprise for haemodialysis service. MSME certificate from manufacturer or other service providers will not be considered. This document must be submitted to claim EMD exemption. Registered vendors of JIPMER are not entitled to EMD exemption.

6. Amendments

- 6.1. At any time before the deadline for submission of bids, the JIPMER, Puducherry may, for any reason, whether at own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the bidding document through amendment. Same will be uploaded at our website. All amendments will be uploaded on the website regularly at www.jipmer.edu.in or the CPPP Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in/epublish/app>
- 6.2. JIPMER, Puducherry shall not be responsible to notify the amendments to individual bidders.
- 6.3. All such amendments by the JIPMER, Puducherry shall be binding on the participatory bidders.
- 6.4. All addendums/Corrigendum’s relating to this will appear only in www.jipmer.edu.in (JIPMER website) and at the CPPP website only). Please visit our website at www.jipmer.edu.in or the CPPP Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in/epublish/app> regularly for further details and updates.
- 6.5. To provide reasonable time to the prospective bidders to take necessary action in preparing their tenders as per the amendment, or any other reasons, the purchaser may, at its discretion extend the deadline for submission of tender and other allied time frames, which are linked with that deadline.

7. Instructions to bidder

- 7.1. Interested bidders are advised to download the complete Tender Enquiry document from the websites www.jipmer.edu.in or <https://eprocure.gov.in/epublish/app> for complete details.
- 7.2. Bidders are requested to read the bidders document on e-Tender web site link before proceeding for bidding.
- 7.3. The bidders shall submit the required EMD through SBI collect only before the due date and time mentioned above.
- 7.4. **Bidders shall ensure that their tender(s), complete in all respects, are submitted by post in a sealed envelope labelled as “Operating outpatient Haemodialysis services in JIPMER Yanam premises” This envelope should have two separate sealed envelopes inside it labelled as 1. Technical bid and 2. Price bid to HOD Nephrology, SSB block, JIPMER, Puducherry 605006.**
- 7.5. **Bids by hand or in person will not be accepted.**
- 7.6. **The bidder should ensure that the bids are valid for 180 days from the closing date of this tender. In case the validity is less than the above stated duration, bid will be rejected.**
- 7.7. The printout of the receipt for payment of EMD must be scanned and sent.
- 7.8. Prospective bidders are advised to browse the above websites regularly before submission of their bids as any further amendments will be published in these websites only.

8. Overview of the project:

- 8.1. JIPMER Yanam multispecialty consulting unit (JYM SCU), Yanam, Puducherry, intent to start offering outpatient haemodialysis services under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Model at the JYM SCU, Yanam, Puducherry.
- 8.2. This shall be a pilot project for one year to assess feasibility
- 8.3. The objective is to make good-quality haemodialysis accessible to the population of Yanam and its adjacent region
- 8.4. JYM SCU, Yanam, shall provide the space, water supply and electricity free of cost to the private partner (service provider) at the JYM SCU Building, Yanam.

- 8.5. The private partner (service provider) shall install all necessary equipment, ensure proper maintenance of the equipment, employ a sufficient number of qualified and trained personnel to operate the haemodialysis services, provide all necessary consumables and shall ensure uninterrupted services at the dialysis unit
- 8.6. The private partner (service provider) shall be paid for the services by JYMSCU, Yanam, and the service provider shall not charge the patients directly for the services provided.
- 8.7. The O&M charges shall be paid to the Agency by JYMSCU, Yanam, monthly at the rate offered in the financial bid.
- 8.8. The JYMSCU, Yanam, shall enroll patients through its authorized personnel. The agency shall not entertain or enroll patients at the dialysis centre on its own.
- 8.9. It is estimated that 9 dialysis session will run per day on 6 days a week. This number may increase or decrease. There is no minimum number guaranteed.

9. **Scope of work- Haemodialysis service:**

- 9.1. The private partner (service provider) shall install **at least three** haemodialysis machines at the Dialysis Unit at JYMSCU, Yanam. The haemodialysis machines installed should be in excellent working condition and have a valid warranty/comprehensive maintenance contract with the original equipment manufacturer.
- 9.2. The private partner (service provider) shall install a water treatment plant to provide water at AAMI-recommended standards for dialysis treatment. The water treatment plant should have a capacity of minimum 500 litres per hour.
- 9.3. The private partner (service provider) shall install all necessary equipment for reprocessing of the dialyser at the dialysis unit, JYMSCU, Yanam. The reprocessed dialysers shall be stored safely to prevent cross-contamination and use a reliable mechanism to avoid a mix up of dialysers between patients
- 9.4. The dialyser used shall be biocompatible (polysulfone, polyethersulfone, or a mixture of synthetic material) and shall be low-flux and BIS/ISI certified.
- 9.5. The private partner (service provider) shall provision dialysers of different surface areas at the dialysis unit. The surface area of the dialysers used should be at least 80% of the patient's body surface area.
- 9.6. Reprocessed dialysers should not be used more than nine times (a maximum use of 10 times, including the first use)
- 9.7. All dialysis-oriented consumables and drugs necessary for offering dialysis services (e.g: **inj. Erythropoietin, Inj. Heparin, Antiseptic solutions, Local Anaesthetic**) shall be procured by the private partner (service provider). The service provider shall calculate the month-wise requirement of consumables & drugs and keep sufficient stock for uninterrupted services.
- 9.8. The dialysis unit at JYMSCU, Yanam, shall remain open six days a week (other than Sundays) with at least three dialysis sessions per machine in a day (three dialysis treatment shifts a day).
- 9.9. The private partner (service provider) shall make all arrangements for its staff relief, leaves, travel, etc. and shall ensure uninterrupted services to the dialysis patients
- 9.10. The private partner (service provider) shall make available the services of a qualified Nephrologist (DM/DNB Nephrology from a recognized university or an equivalent degree), who shall visit the dialysis unit and assess patients at least once a week
- 9.11. All arrangements, such as Tabs/computers/cameras/Mobiles/ internet connection etc., towards management of video calls to nephrologists, if necessary, shall be the responsibility of the agency.
- 9.12. All patients enrolled for haemodialysis at the centre shall be tested at the baseline for HBV, HCV & HIV infection with tests for HBsAg (ELISA/ECLIA), IgG Anti HCV (ELISA/ECLIA) and HIV 1 & 2 (ELISA or rapid diagnostic kits approved by NACO) at the time of enrolment and every three months subsequently. These tests are available at the JYMSCU, Yanam

- 9.13. Patients who are known to have HBV, HCV or HIV infection or who test positive for any of these infections at the time of screening before enrolment shall not be offered HD services at JYMSCU. They shall be referred elsewhere for dialysis treatment until an isolation facility is created at the JYMSCU dialysis unit.
- 9.14. The private partner (service provider) has to ensure the disinfection of Hemodialysis machines regularly after every dialysis session, as the manufacturer recommends.
- 9.15. Only patients enrolled by the designated medical officer at JYMSCU, Yanam, shall be provided dialysis treatment by the agency.
- 9.16. In the absence of dialysis slots, patients requesting enrollment at the dialysis centre shall be registered on a waiting list maintained by the doctor in charge of the dialysis centre. Such patients shall be allotted dialysis slots as and when they become vacant.
- 9.17. Personnel appointed by JYMSCU, Yanam, shall reserve the right to monitor performance periodically or anytime as decided by the doctor of JYMSCU. However, the agency shall be primarily responsible to the local administration for the day-to-day operation and other contractual obligations.
- 9.18. The service provider shall maintain a complaint register to record or register patient(s) grievances/complaints.
- 9.19. The Agency will return the wastewater from the water treatment plant at the dialysis unit without any charge to JYMSCU, Yanam, for recycling/conservation, if required.
- 9.20. The private partner (service provider) shall ensure compliance with statutory requirements, if any.
- 9.21. The Service Provider shall ensure that all the relevant licenses/ registrations/ permissions which may be required for providing the services under this contract are valid during the entire period of the Agreement; failing which the Buyer can take appropriate action
- 9.22. The private partner (service provider) shall be responsible for any negligence during dialysis and shall indemnify JYMCU of all liabilities. In this regard the bidder shall take insurance and a copy of the same will be shared with the Buyer.
- 9.23. The private partner (service provider) shall ensure adherence to the haemodialysis standards recommended by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi [\[358.pdf\]](#) STANDARD TREATMENT GUIDELINES HAEMODIALYSIS The Clinical Establishments (Registration and Regulation) Act
- 9.24. Advertising of the dialysis services at JYMSCU, Yanam, through any medium, including visual, print or social media, by the private partner (service provider) is strictly prohibited
- 9.25. The private partner (service provider) shall NOT make public announcements or claim credits publically for offering haemodialysis services at JYMSCU, Yanam through any form of media, including visual, print or social media
- 9.26. Only the name 'JYMSCU Outpatient Haemodialysis Centre, Yanam' shall be displayed at the dialysis unit, its premises and on any printed or digital materials like patient educational material, dialysis chart, dialysis records provided to the patients, etc. No other names or identities shall be printed or displayed on the dialysis centre premises or in any print or digital material.
- 9.27. Confidentiality of all patients to be maintained as per applicable laws
- 9.28. JYMSCU, Yanam, shall provide routine lab tests required before, during and after the hemodialysis treatment, as well as for regular monitoring of the patient outcomes. The private partner (service provider) shall be responsible for ensuring the lab tests are performed as per the standard operating procedure, shall be responsible for collecting and compiling the lab reports and the Nephrologist visiting the dialysis unit shall review the lab reports periodically
- 9.29. The collection and disposal of biomedical waste already collected in a segregated manner by the service provider at the dialysis centre shall be the responsibility of JYMSCU, Yanam. The staff employed by the service provider shall be responsible for collecting biomedical and office waste in the dialysis centre, adhering to biomedical waste management rules with proper segregation and packing and

storing it in a manner to facilitate subsequent collection of the same and disposal by JYMSCU, Yanam. Cleaning and upkeep of dialysis unit shall be the responsibility of the service provider.

- 9.30. JYMSCU, Yanam, reserves the right to increase machines at the exact cost and terms & conditions at the precise location or another location within the JIPMER consulting unit, Yanam campus, if necessary.
- 9.31. The service provider will maintain a register of all the cases performed on daily basis. This data should **be biometrically captured** with the recommended device to be provided by the service provider. This is mandatory for insurance claims.

10. Method of evaluating the tenders

- 10.1. On the given date and time tenders will be opened. In case last date happens to be holiday, tender opening will be done immediate next working day.
- 10.2. Envelopes labelled as Technical bids alone will be opened. Bidders will be evaluated for technical compliance.
- 10.3. Those qualifying in technical compliance will be considered for price bid opening
- 10.4. Date of price bid opening will be announced in due course.

11. Award of contract

- 11.1. The bidder who is technically compliant and has quoted the lowest rate for per session dialysis will be intimated for the awarded of the contract.
- 11.2. The successful bidder must submit **performance security of Rs. 100,000 (one lakh only)** within 2 weeks on intimation, failing which the award of contract will be cancelled. Mode of payment will be similar to EMD.
- 11.3. Performance security will be held for two months beyond the end of contract.
- 11.4. The successful bidder must sign and submit a contract, a draft of which will be provided in due course, in a non-judicial bond paper of Rs 100 (2 sets) within 2 weeks, failing which the award of contract will summarily be cancelled.

12. Performance parameters and Penalty

13. **Payment:** the bidder will maintain a register of daily dialysis performed. This data should be biometrically captured. Invoice will be generated by the service provider on **monthly basis including GST**. After the invoice

is verified by the appointed JYMSCU officer, payment will be done on monthly basis after deducting penalties, if any.

14. Termination of contract

- 14.1. Lack of maintenance of service level agreement.
- 14.2. Termination of convenience. Either party without assigning any reason, may terminate the contract after giving three months' notice. During this period the successful bidder is obliged to provide uninterrupted and full service.
- 14.3. Termination on grounds of insolvency. The contract will cease immediately
- 14.4. Force Majeure: If a Force Majeure situation arises, the service provider shall promptly notify the Purchaser/Consignee in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof within twenty one days of occurrence of such event. Unless otherwise directed by the Purchaser/Consignee in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event

15. **Subletting of contract:** subletting of contract or part of it is not allowed. If necessary, prior permission from the buyer is mandatory.

16. Dispute resolution

- 16.1. Conciliation: In the event of any conflict or dispute arising out of or in connection with the contract, the Parties shall endeavor to settle such disputes amicably. If a dispute is not resolved within 30 (thirty) days after a written notice of any dispute by one Party to the other, the same shall then be resolved through the mechanism of a Dispute Resolution Committee. This Dispute Resolution Committee shall comprise of representatives of both the Buyer and the Seller / Service Provider and shall be chaired by the Primary User of the Buyer organization/department or any other person as authorized by the Primary User. If the Dispute Resolution Committee is not able to resolve the matter within 30(thirty) days of its formation, the dispute shall then be referred to Arbitration.
- 16.2. Arbitration: In the event of any conflict / dispute arising out of or in connection with the Contract not been resolved by conciliation, Arbitral Tribunal will be formed as per mutual agreement.
- 16.3. The place of Arbitration will be at JIPMER, Puducherry and the language shall be English.
- 16.4. The Director of JIPMER, reserves the right to cancel this tender in whole or in part without assigning any reason. No compensation will be paid to the bidder in case the contract is cancelled.

17. Laws Governing the Contract:

- 17.1. The contract shall be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force.
- 17.2. Irrespective of the place of delivery, the place of performance or the place of payment under the contract, the contract shall be deemed to have been made at the registered address of the Buyer and / or Primary Buyer (JIPMER, Puducherry)
- 17.3. Jurisdiction of Courts: The courts of the place from where the contract has been made shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract. (Puducherry court)
