Topic : PRIMARY IMMUNODEFICIENCY DISORDERS (PIDS)

Summary: Primary Immunodeficiency disorders (PIDs) are a heterogenous group of >400 rare chronic disorders, characterized by inherited defects in the immune system predisposing the patient susceptible to life threatening infections in children and adults. In recent years, research in Primary immunodeficiency is making rapid strides leading to better understanding of the underlying mechanisms, ethnic differences on clinical presentation, improving treatment options and enhancing the quality of life. Treatment options are targeted towards the specific immune defects and can include hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, antibody replacement, preventive antibiotics and strategies to manage autoimmune diseases. Further, gene therapy has been successful in specific types of PIDD.

Patients with PID may first present to rheumatologists, gastroenterologists, hematologists, oncologists, dermatologists, pulmonologists, allergists, and ENT specialists. Therefore, there is a need for increased awareness among and education of clinicians in different specialties.

This introductory course to be held on 1st March 2020 at AIIMS Bhopal from 9:00am to 5:30 pm to PID aims to educate clinicians and laboratory personnel about diagnosis, immunological basis and treatment of PID through case studies and lectures from experts in the field from India and USA including PGIMER, AIIMS Delhi, SGPGI, NIIH, Wadia Children's hospital and others.
